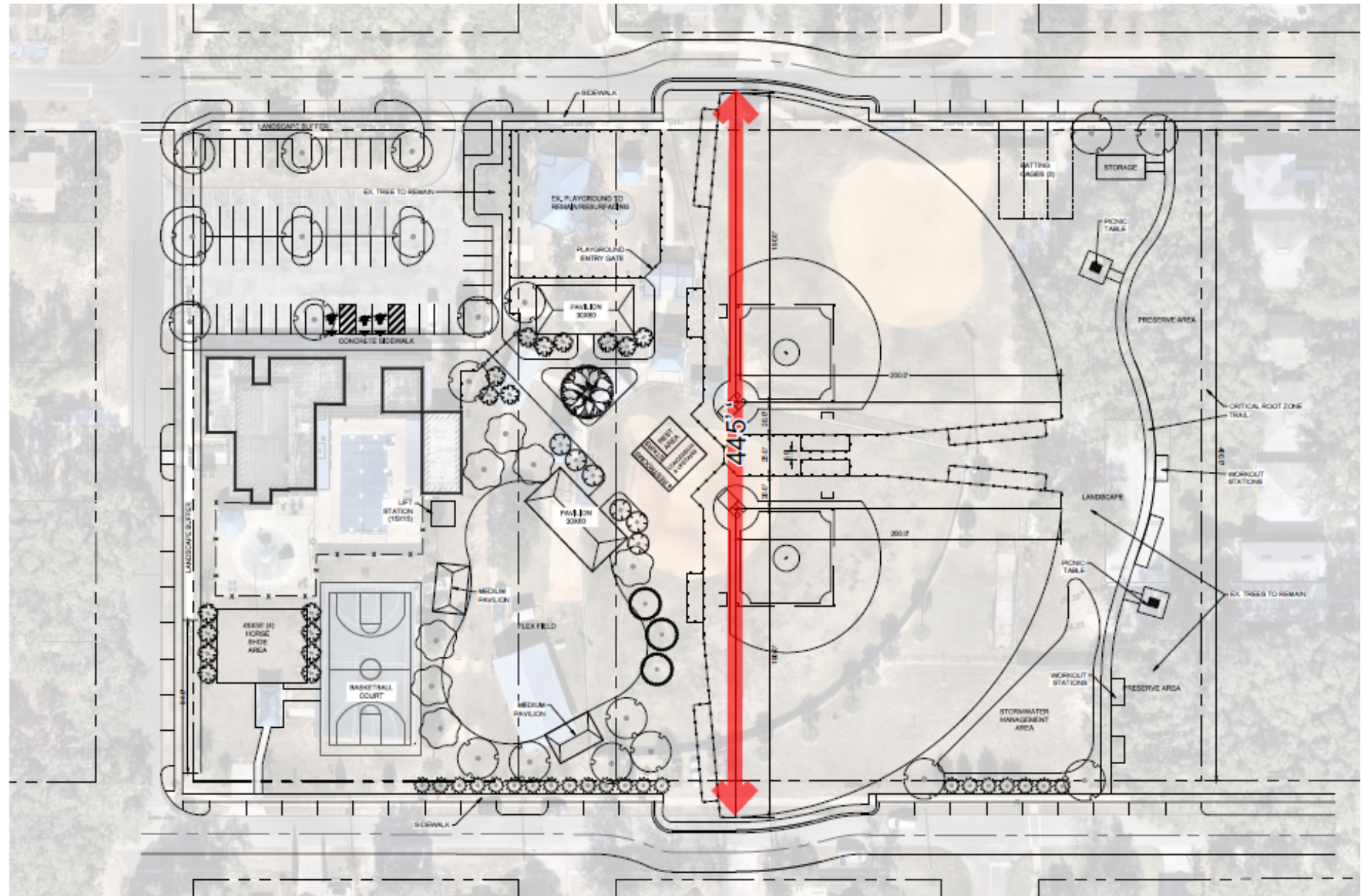

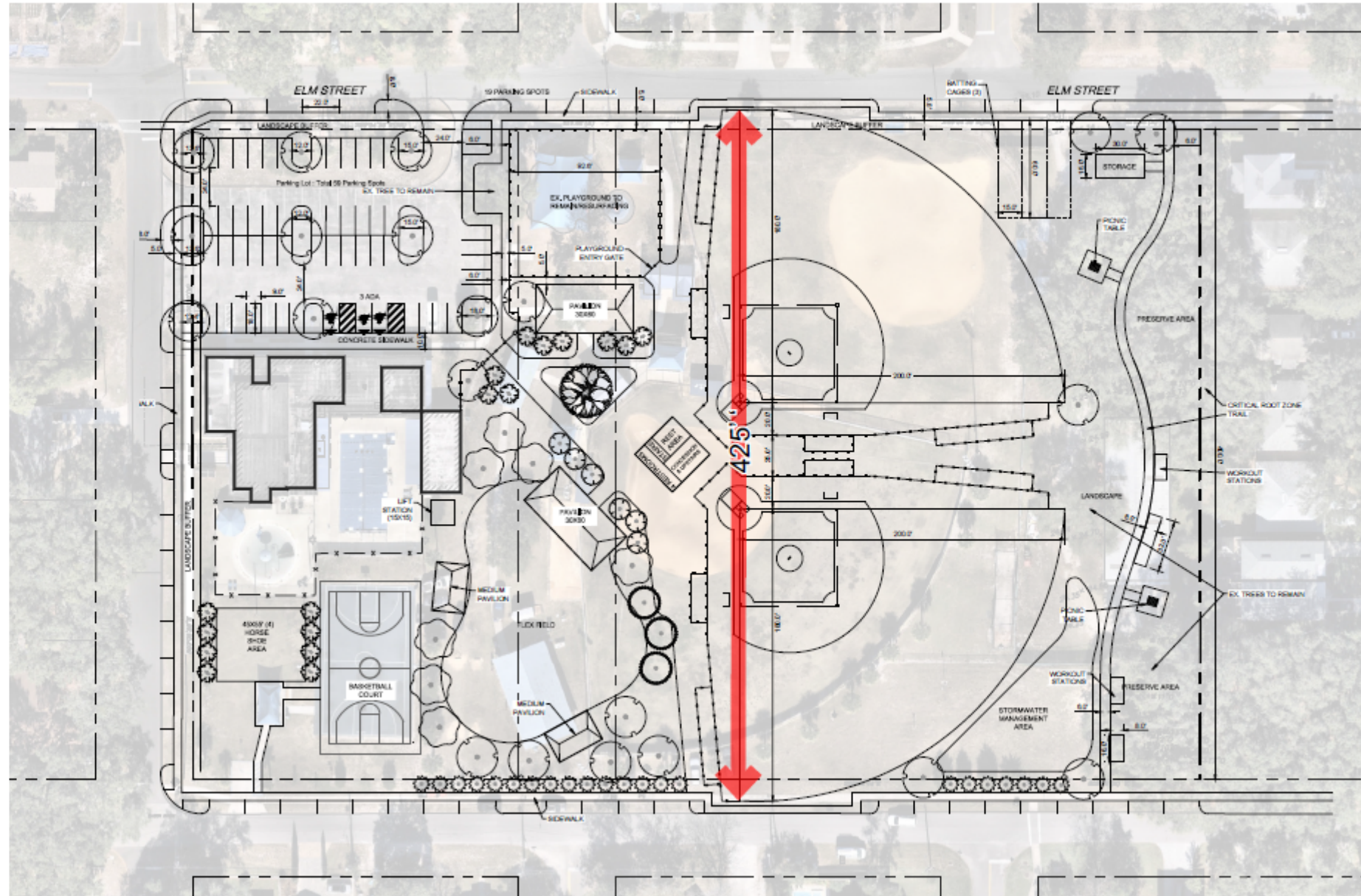

- IMPACTS ROW AND ROAD ALIGNMENT



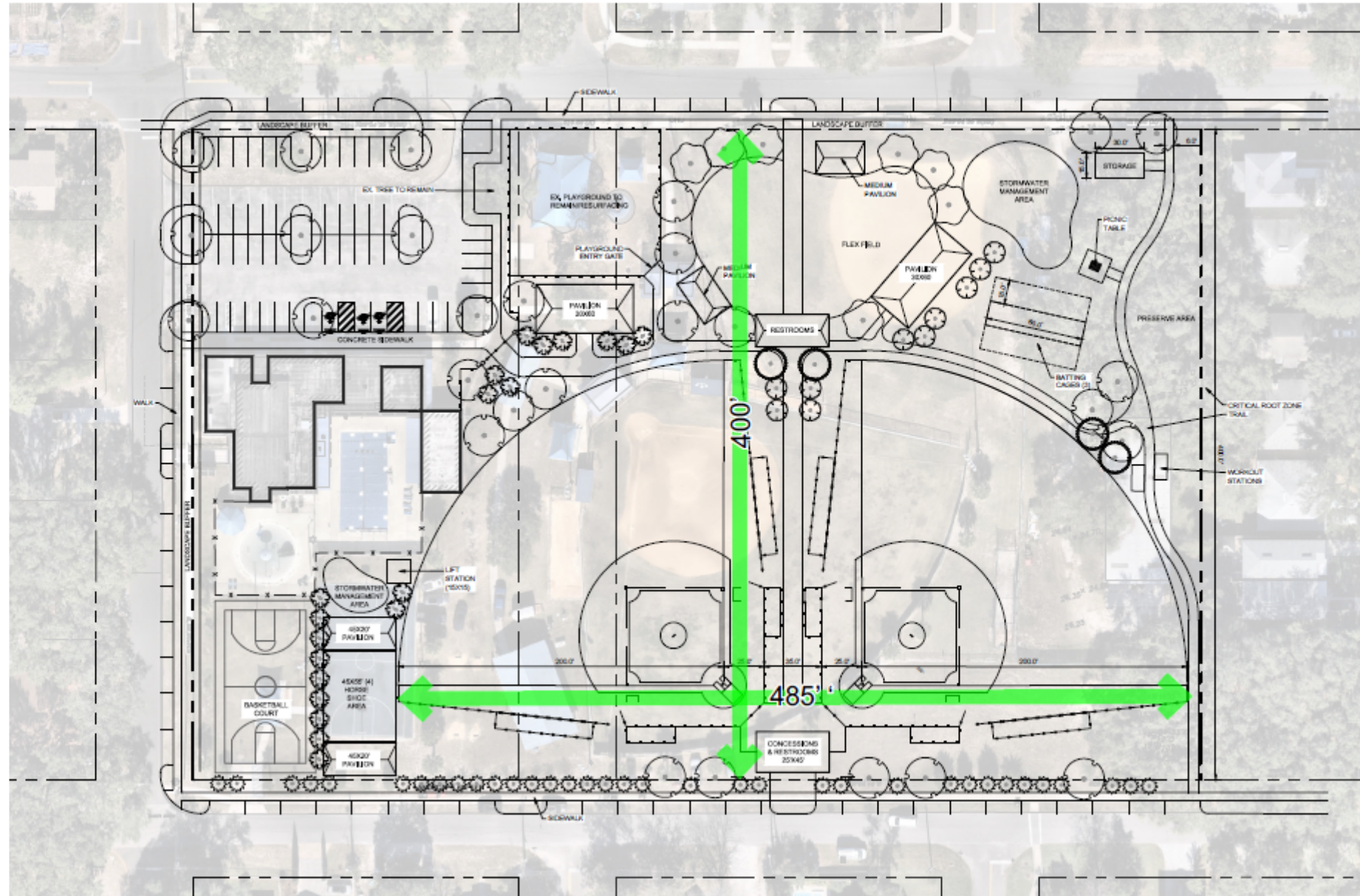
OPTION 2

OPTION 3

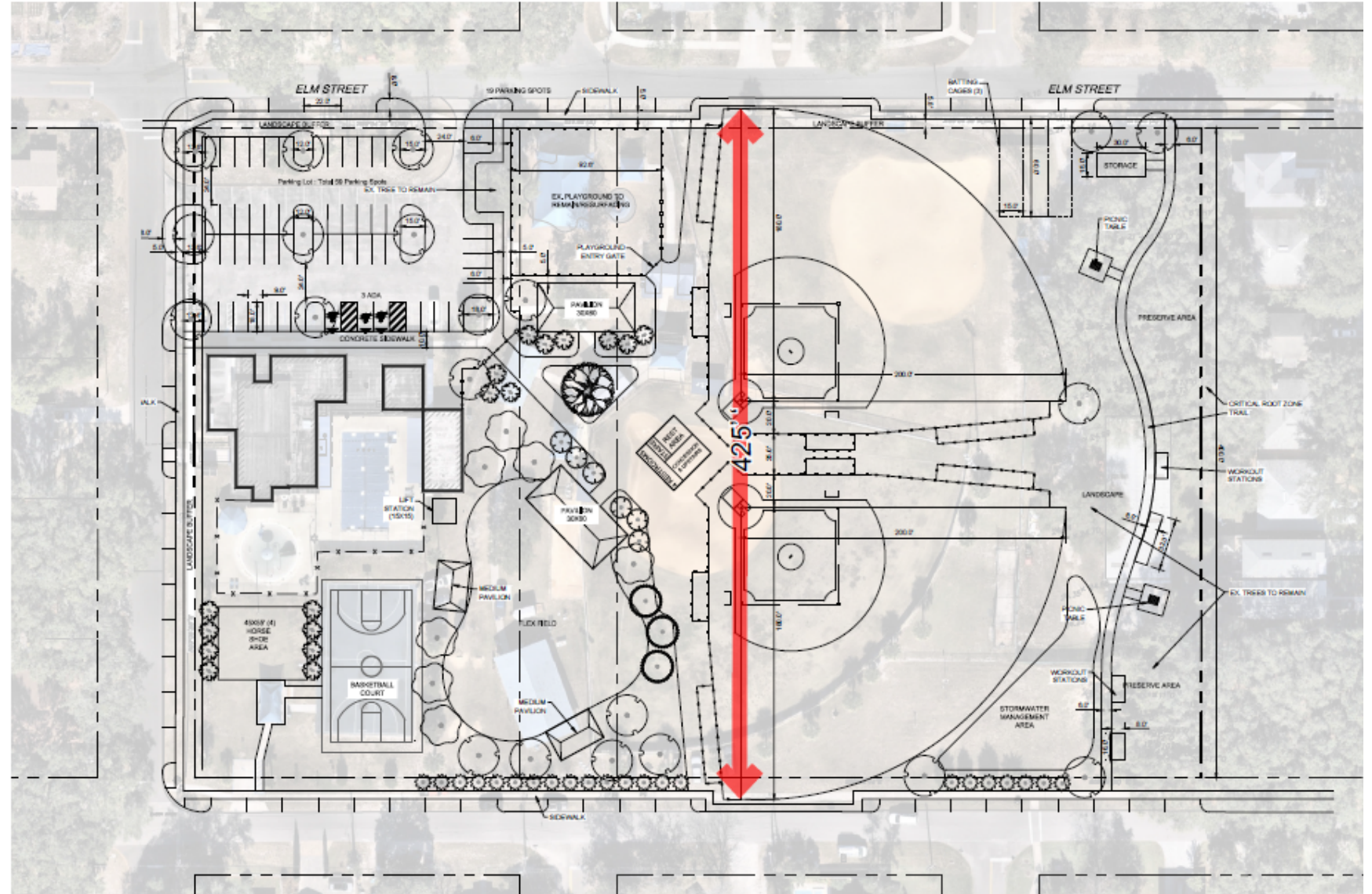

Ideally, Little League would like to see a 200-foot outfield fence dimension. That said, fields that fall within approximately 10% of that distance are typically considered for approval. When feasible, a higher outfield fence can also help achieve the level of play and field characteristics Little League strives for. As you described your two areas of 180' would be sufficient.

District 11 Little League is very excited about the proposed two new fields at Elm Street Park. We believe these fields will be a tremendous asset to your community, and we look forward to the opportunity for Elm Street Little League to host both baseball and softball tournament play. Beyond benefiting your local program, these fields will also provide additional tournament opportunities for Little League programs throughout the Jacksonville area.
