Old Business

Call for Content: Mary Hamburg put out the call for content on both social media and the newspaper

Museum Content: Dale Martin did a brown bag presentation at the museum on games. Mary will approach museum about putting up that content

Discussed putting City Commission meetings up on PEG station:

- Mary's time is all it costs to embed closed captions with video
- would encourage City engagement
- Would be put in the loop and be changed out every two weeks
- need to promote PEG Channel /Commission meetings to new people moving to town
- low income and fixed income demographic receives package deal of tv and internet from Comcast and households with school age children can get free cable
- Anthony thought cable is the only way to reach that demographic
- Mary will promote that City meetings will be on PEG
- Judie will write a press release for the newspaper re: Fernandina TV that Mary will circulate to members before going to press

Anthony asked if there's a way to get figures on Comcast viewership of Live meeting stream because Comcast should be able to pull viewership. Question is how to find the person who knows.
